The vine -

Plot/climat Longbois

History This parcel is an enclave in the woods above Champs Pimont.

Soil Silty, very chalky, stony and not very deep.

Our plot(s) 30a and 54ca planted in 1987, and grafted in 2000. Situated at an altitude of 310m, this hilltop parcel is at the edge of the woods. Facing east/southeast, with a slight slope.

The wine -

100% Chardonnay from handpicked grapes; vinified and raised in oak casks.

Taste The parcel's altitude produces straightforward, taut, mineral wines with notes of citrus and fresh fruit. A few Pinot Noir vines remain, giving the wine a certain roundness.

Serving temperature 12/14°C. It is recommended to decant recent vintages so as to enhance the aroma.
